COVID-19 Outbreak update:

I would like to provide a quick update going into the weekend. Resident and staff cases continue (no new cases for 2 days), at this time symptoms appear to be relatively mild in most cases. Staff continue to monitor all residents for symptoms. Activities have been provided on the home areas and socializing in lounges continues. Residents will continue to receive meal trays with choices being offered each meal. Visits continue to be limited to Essential Caregivers.

Public Health has directed that universal masking should be implemented, and Valley Manor will implement this change **effective today, February 6, 2026.**

- Staff, volunteers, students, support workers and visitors will be required to wear a mask to work or visit.
 - Masking and use of other PPE is required when a resident is isolating.
- Visitors are to self-monitor for symptoms at home. Visitors will still be requested to sign in with detail of who is being visited. Please do not visit if ill.
